## **Welcome to Parent Cue App Customization!**

Your Orange Apps: Parent Cue App subscription provides a way for you to make the Parent Cue App uniquely yours.

You can customize your lesson to fit exactly what you are teaching on the weekend. You can use the Orange curriculum or add a new Bible story.

You can change the **order of XP3 series** for your students or add your own content.

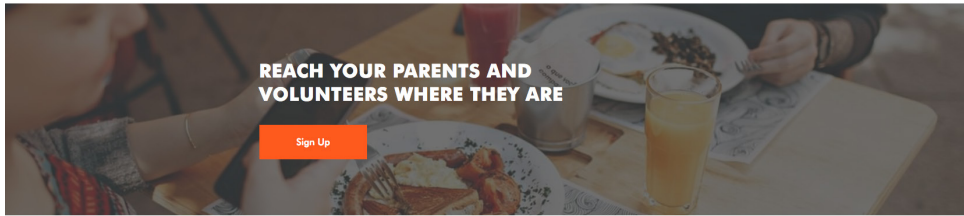
You can send customized notifications within the app to specific groups of parents.

You can also customize the content in Spanish.

Your parents will now be prompted to set up an individual account for their family. They will be asked to identify their church, which means you'll see a roster of your families. This account will also transfer to new devices they use in the future.

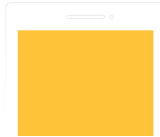

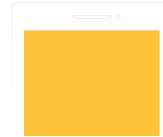

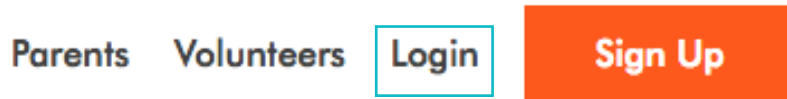

2. In the menu at the top of the page, select LOGIN.



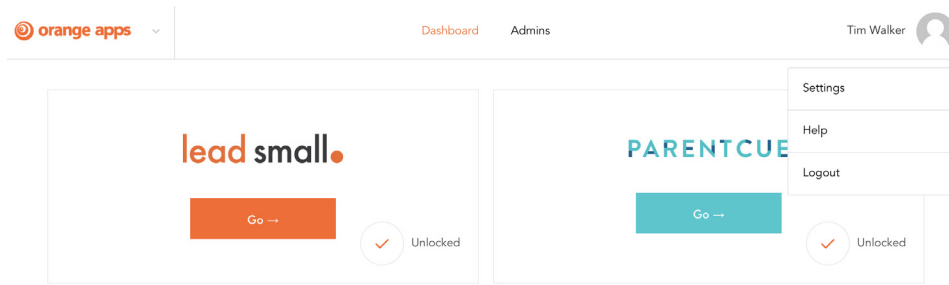
3. Enter your username and password you created when you purchased your Parent Cue App customization. (Don't remember it? Don't worry. There's a "forgot" option.)

# **Your Account**

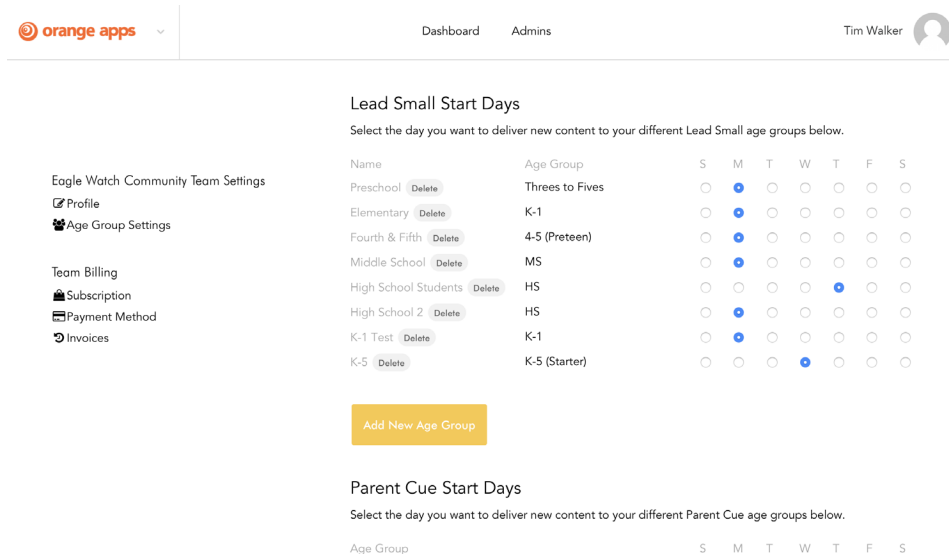
To manage your account, click on the profile icon in the top right corner. You will see three options—Settings, Help, and Logout. Click on Settings.



On the next screen, the page you are seeing is the Age Group Settings page. (We'll talk more about that in a minute.)

Also, on the sidebar on this page, you will see menu options for both Team Settings and Team Billing.

Select Profile under Team Settings.



## TEAM SETTINGS: PROFILE

In PROFILE, you can adjust the contact information (name and email address) for the primary user on the account, change your password, and edit your team name. You can even add a profile photo if you want.

Set up your Team Name. Even though it seems minor, this is an important step. When you invite users to the account, you need your Team Name to appear on the email invite.

## TEAM BILLING

Next, under Team Billing on the sidebar menu, select SUBSCRIPTION. If you are the Team Owner, this is where you could add another Orange Apps subscription (for example, Lead Small) or cancel your subscription. (Only the Team Owner has access to these items!)

Click on PAYMENT METHOD to change your subscription to a different credit card.

Click on INVOICES to print out an invoice for your monthly or annual bill.

## ADDING ADDITIONAL TEAM MEMBERS TO YOUR ACCOUNT (ADMINS)

Want to add additional users to this account? Click on "Admins" in the top navigation bar.

Select "Add Admin."

Enter the first name, last name, email, and phone number of the person you want to add. Select whether you want that user to have access to Lead Small or Parent Cue, or both. Then click SAVE.

The system will send that individual an email inviting them to join the site.

# **Content**

## **English**

Select the Age Group for your content. You can choose from one of the following:

- Baby (0 yrs)
- Toddler (1 yrs)
- Preschool (2-5 yrs)
- Elementary (K- 3rd Grade)
- Preteen (4th & 5th Grade)
- Middle School (6th-8th Grade)
- High School (9th-12th Grade)

To the right of the Age group is the dates of the current week. Select the arrow for the drop-down menu, and then select the week you want to review/customize. Parent Cue content is posted weekly, not daily or monthly. (We don't want parents to get overloaded with information.)

### Want to launch your content on another day besides Sunday?

No problem!

Orange Content will default to start on Sunday, but you have the option to choose another day for specific age groups. Simply select "Manage Start Dates" (see above image) and you can adjust the start date for all, or just some age groups. For example, if your Student Ministry meets on Wednesday nights, but your Children's Ministry meets on Sundays, you can select a different start date for each to reflect when they meet. Once you select the content, the fields for that particular age group will automatically populate each section. You can then customize your content.

As you start customizing content, here are some things to keep in mind:

- For Toddler, Preschool, Elementary, and Preteen, there is a **WATCH THIS** section. This section links to a video created by Orange.

**ADDING A CUSTOM VIDEO.** To replace the default Orange video with your own video, load the YouTube ID of your own video. (The YouTube ID is not the entire URL of the video you uploaded to YouTube. It's only the last part of your YouTube URL or link. Just select and copy everything past the "v" in the link and paste it into Orange Apps.

**NOTE:** Adding custom video **ONLY** works with videos loaded to YouTube since the video player in the app is made by YouTube.

**REPLACING THE BIBLE STORY.** If you choose to change the Bible story content, the video box will disappear and the box will become **READ THIS**. You will then be able to enter the Bible story title and reference of your choice.

The other fields for customization are Remember This, Think About This, and Do This. These sections provide a unique customization open. In these sections, you can:

- make text **BOLD**
- make text *ITALIC*
- underline text
- add a hyperlink

To view these options, simply highlight the text you want to format with your cursor. A hyperlink is a good option for those of you who want to provide parents with resources to help them do what you are mentioning, or even alternate videos you may want them to see—since video can't be uploaded to the app.

Let's take a closer look at the other sections.

- **Remember This:** Remember This is the section for the Bible verse. If your church uses a different translation of the Bible verse provided by Orange, this is an easy way to make sure things are aligned internally. This section does offer formatting tools for the content, but not the Bible reference.

- **Think About This:** This section provides additional information or instruction to parents to help them help their child or teen process the information being taught.

- **Do This:** The Do This section encourages parents to make the most of the moments they have every day with their child. Every week, we provide a specific cue to encourage parents to seize a moment that is already a part of their everyday rhythm (like Meal Time, Drive Time, Bed Time, etc.). If you decide to replace the cues provided, then this section becomes simply a “Do This” section that will allow you to enter whatever content you choose.

### DID YOU ENTER CONTENT INTO THE APP BUT CHANGED YOUR MIND?

**No problem.** The “reset content” button is above each entry field when you start replacing content, and once selected, the default Orange content will appear again in the text fields.

### Manage Parent Cue Supported Languages

- Spanish

Go back up to the top left corner and underneath the Orange Apps logo, select Parent Cue.

Select Content and then select an Age Group. You will view the pre-loaded content. You will also see a new drop down menu located on the right hand side, that allows you to view the English or Spanish pre-loaded content.

If you wish, you have the ability to customize both English and Spanish content. This works for all age groups, but there are a few additional things you will need to know if you customize Middle School and High School content. We'll cover that in a minute.

Also, note, the video that Spanish users will see for toddlers, preschool, elementary, or preteen is shown in English. There isn't a Spanish version of the video.

If you don't customize Spanish content, the default Orange content will be sent in Spanish to those parents whose phone language is set to Spanish, or they can choose to receive the content in Spanish within the app settings. However if you customize your English content, make sure to customize your Spanish content as well so they will match.

## VIEWING & CUSTOMIZING XP3 MS & HS CONTENT

Select Content. Scroll down within this box to see all the age groups. Select Age group, and then Middle School or High School.

You will then see content pre-loaded from our XP3 Middle School and XP3 High School curriculum teams that corresponds with the recommended scope and cycle.

If you choose to do nothing, parents will receive middle school and high school content either in English or Spanish according to the scope and cycle, and according to the language settings on their phone.

However, if you wish to customize the content, make sure you make the changes in both English and Spanish. Otherwise, your content won't match.

If you decide to reorder XP3 content and do an XP3 series in a different order than the scope and cycle, you'll need to select a series and a week other than the pre-loaded content, and load it. You will have to do this for both the English and Spanish version of the series as well. Otherwise, your content won't be the same for that week in the series.

# **Notifications**

The customized version of the Parent Cue App offers push and in-app notifications. This tool is a great way for your church to send messages to the families connected to your church, with content tailored to different age groups in your church about specific events or information.

Go to the Notifications Tab at the top. Then click on the Add Notification button.


## Add Notification

You are now ready to create your notification. You can send notifications to parents or a child in a specific age group, or you can "Select All" and send a notification to everyone connected to your church through the Parent Cue App. You can also select two or more age groups if you choose. **Push notifications will be sent to people connected to your church AND who have push notifications turned on.** In-app notifications will be sent to all people connected to your church.

For families of children with mild or moderate special needs, you also have the ability to send a notification just to them.

Selecting one or more (or all) age groups is required for each notification.

If you are sending a notification to families with children with mild or moderate special needs, select one or all.

Create a title for your notification. Then in the text box, type your message. You can format your text (bold, underline, italic, bullet points, centering, etc.) but you do not have the option to add images. You can also add a link (select the chain icon) in your notification in case you want to direct parents to a specific web page, resource, or sign up page.

Once you've created your notification, you can send it now or schedule it to be sent later. You also have the option to schedule an expiration date if you want the notification to automatically delete on a certain date (like after an event).

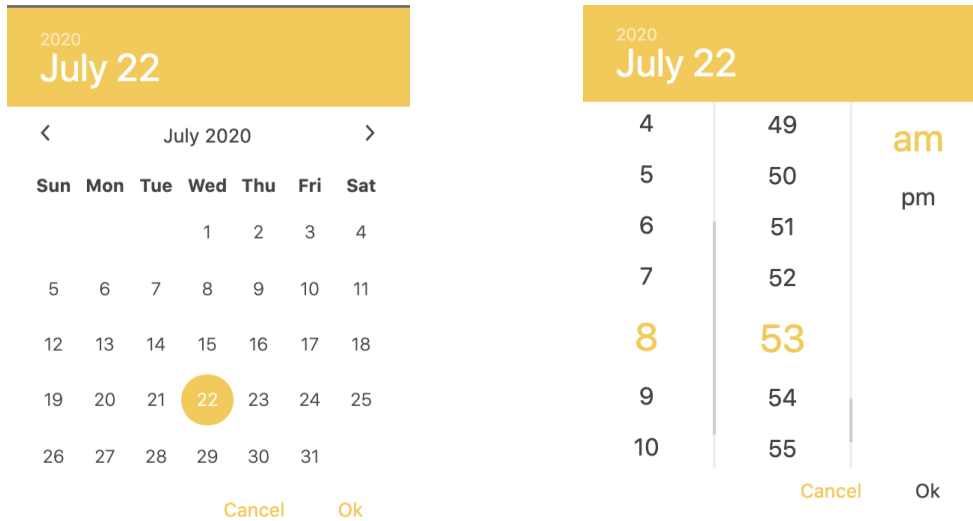

You will then be directed to the following screens where you can schedule your notification to be sent on a specific date and at a specific time. All times shown are Eastern Standard Time.



Once you click Ok on the time you want the notification to be sent, your notification is then scheduled.

But WAIT! Did you forget to do something? Did you want to make a change to the content or select different age groups? Do you need to send the message out sooner? No problem. Simply click on the pencil icon shown below and you can edit your notification.

You also have the option to delete old notifications once they are no longer needed by simply clicking the "X" to the right of the pencil icon.
